The directors of the FECU guarantee to keep you in a close relationship with the students and the staff of the school and to report regularly on the progress of the students you have chosen to sponsor.

In the course of responding to the ever increasing demand for help in Uganda, we organized in November for the second time a Bowl-a-thon fundraiser and attracted the participation of 137 people of all ages as old as 4 and as young as 90 years. It was a happy event with much laughter, joy and excitement and brought people from a number of parishes together. It was an event truly conducted in the spirit of charity, serving God's children in need. The net revenue of this event amounted to \$2,435.25. It

is most encouraging to see again how much a difference each one of our benefactors can make in the life of our students who now can proceed in their studies without having to worry about school fees and other expenses. Through the FECU, all our benefactors can be assured that every penny raised is serving the needs of our students in the school.
